

ARIN Intermediate Unit 28 Guest Teacher Program

Overview:

Due to a shortage of certified substitute teachers and as a service to our member school districts, ARIN Intermediate Unit 28 operates a Guest Teacher program to provide quality substitute teacher training for those with limited or no teaching experience.*

Guest Teacher candidates attend a two-day orientation conducted by ARIN IU 28 administrators and educational consultants that includes an introduction to various aspects of education and a formal interview.

Following the orientation, prospective Guest Teachers then spend a day observing in area classrooms.

Each successful Guest Teacher candidate exits the program with 1) a basic understanding of what is needed to be a substitute teacher; and 2) an emergency permit issued by the Pennsylvania Department of Education (PDE) that allows him/her to substitute teach on a day-to-day basis in participating school districts. *Note:* ARIN IU 28 applies for and holds the emergency permit.

**NOTE: Those with PA teaching certificates are NOT eligible for the Guest Teacher Program and should contact directly those districts in which they wish to substitute.*

What are the requirements to be a Guest Teacher?

- A Bachelor's Degree from an accredited college or university.
 - * May be in *any field* - does not have to be in education.
 - * A teaching certificate is not required.
- Submit a completed ARIN IU 28 Guest Teacher application, including the following:
 - * Required background clearances (child abuse, state criminal and federal criminal checks)
 - * Original, sealed transcripts verifying receipt of Bachelor's Degree
 - * Physical/TB form
- Successful completion of the ARIN IU 28 Guest Teacher two-day orientation (including a formal interview) and one day of classroom observations.

What costs are involved? Applicants must pay \$25 to cover the costs for meals and materials associated with the required two-day Guest Teacher Orientation. Also, the costs for clearances (approximately \$55), transcripts, and the physical/TB test must be paid by the Guest Teacher.

What subjects may I teach and is there a limit to how many days I may substitute during a school year? You may substitute in any subject area for an unlimited number of days; however, you may NOT work more than 20 cumulative days in a single assignment (i.e., more than 20 total days during a school year for the same teacher).

What will I earn? Substitute teacher rates vary by district, but generally range from \$75 to \$90/day. Specific information will be shared during the orientation.

Who participates in the ARIN IU 28 Guest Teacher Consortium? (NOTE: This list is tentative – any updated information for 2011-12 will be distributed at the Guest Teacher Orientation.)

- ARIN IU 28 (in IU-operated special education classrooms in various districts)
- Armstrong School District
- Blairsville-Saltsburg School District
- Freeport Area School District
- Indiana Area School District (NOTE: Although a member of the consortium, due to sufficient substitutes at this time, IASD will NOT be accepting any new/additional Guest Teachers until further notice.)
- Marion Center Area School District
- Penns Manor Area School District

May I substitute in districts that do not participate in ARIN's Guest Teacher Consortium? No. The emergency permit issued through ARIN's Guest Teacher Program is good only for districts participating in our consortium.

Must I work in every district? No. During the orientation, you will indicate the districts in which you are willing to work.

How many days must I substitute? There is no minimum. However, to avoid applying for clearances every year, you must substitute at least one day in every school year for each district in which you wish to continue working.

What is a Guest Teacher?

A Guest Teacher serves as a substitute to replace teachers when they are absent from their classrooms.

The primary requirements for becoming a Guest Teacher are 1) completion of a Bachelor's degree program (a teaching certificate is NOT required) and 2) completion of the Guest Teacher training provided by the ARIN Intermediate Unit 28.

NOTE: Those with PA teaching certificates are NOT eligible for the Guest Teacher Program and should contact directly those districts in which they wish to substitute .
